2. Vendors, Spiritual readers/consultants & healers: must have a copy of your Business/Resale License &/or Minister's Credentials. You are also solely responsible for collecting and reporting all sales and income taxes for your business.
3. Fire Extinguisher: All Booths must have a Full & Working Fire Extinguisher in the booth.
4. All participants: will conduct themselves in a well-behaved and lawful manner at all times.
5. Participants: will be responsible for all members of their party.
6. Friday Set up is available from 9:00 am on.
7. Overnight camp out: For vendors & staff in your booth or in a tent to be taken down in the morning.
8. Saturday evening Midsummer Ritual: for participants of the Festival Only (9:00 pm)
9. Saturday morning set up: 7:00 am-9:30 am. Unloading of vehicles will be allowed on festival grounds between 7:00 am and 9:00 am only! All vehicles must be removed from festival area by 9:00 am.
10. All booths: must be set up & ready by 9:30 am, Saturday, June 13, 2009.
11. All booths: must remain open throughout the festival. No vehicles will be allowed back onto the festival grounds until 6:10 pm on Sunday.
12. Food available: The festival will be providing a variety of food for purchase. A breakfast on each day will be available for purchase to staff and vendors from 7:00 am to 9:00 am. (Other fast food, deli, grocery & restaurants are within one mile of our event should you need them.)
13. Limited RV space is available. Contact the promoters for details.
14. Dress: This is a Celtic Themed Magickal Festival. Dress to celebrate Festival! Faerie dress is most welcome of all. For information on traditional Celtic fashion, contact the organizers.
15. Children: under 12 years of age must be attended by a responsible adult at all times!
16. No open flames are allowed in the vendor booths during the festival hours. Candles for sacred ritual purposes or in performances must be enclosed and kept where they may not come in contact with any clothing or other flammable material. A fire extinguisher must be within reach of any candle or flame during ritual or performance.
17. Swords, daggers, ritual blades (over 6") must be sheathed and peace tied at all times. (vendors may safely display & sell)
18. **No firearms or weapons allowed!**
19. **No liquor is allowed to be brought onto the premises of the VFW property/festival area.** The VFW bar will be open for those who wish a drink, but all alcoholic drinks must stay in the bar.
20. Sexy is okay, but no nudity.
21. All vendors, entertainers, and other participants must have an original, signed copy of the Disclaimer and Rules of Conduct on file with the Festival Director prior to participation in the festival.
